

Second day of our journey started with a visit to AMUL Dairy at Anand district of Gujarat. Here, we observed the milk quality control, processing of raw milk into various dairy products, alongside understanding the nutritional value of dairy products and potential impact of dairy farming on environment. Furthermore, we also had a visit to AMUL chocolate plant, where we got to know about the process of making chocolate which involves different stages of chocolate making like roasting, grinding etc. Afterwards we checked in to another hotel- Hotel Petals Unity inn at Kevadia. The destination of the day was Swami Narayan temple at Poicha. It was among the most calm, quiet, gorgeous and scenic place I had gone. It offered a unique experience to understand the rich culture and heritage of India.

On the final day of our journey, we went for jungle safari to Kevadiya where we explored many animals and birds. After lunch we went to world's tallest statue- the statue of unity, 182 m long that honors Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, a leader and statesman in the Indian history, where we saw his full biography on the statue. Then we went to our last destination of our trip to Gujarat that was Glow Garden, which was very elegant and fully decorated with lights.

Students from class 3rd to class 9th and class 11th enthusiastically participated, carrying thought-provoking slogans and messages to emphasize the importance of following traffic rules.








"JOSH" The Annual Sports Meet




A SESSION ON HEALTH & HYGIENE








"A" CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION
